



## BILLINGFORD LAKES FISHERY RULES

Please note Day Fishing Tickets are valid from 7am until 7pm, 24 hour fishing is also available.

Please be kind enough to observe the following rules:-

1. You must have a valid rod license.
2. All anglers must have a purpose-made weigh sling and unhooking mat, and a landing net suitable for specimen fish.
3. NO keep nets. All fish to be returned quickly after weighing and photography.
4. Three rods per person.
5. NO nuts to be used either as hook baits or loose feed.
6. All juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
7. Spinning, lure and dead baiting is available from 1st October – 31<sup>st</sup> March.
  - Must use wire trace, **minimum length of 18"**
  - **Live bait and freshly killed dead baits are banned and must not be brought onto the fishery**
  - **Sea dead baits and frozen coarse dead baits can be used**
  - **Only one prong of any double or treble hook being used for dead-bait fishing shall have a barb for the purpose of bait retention. All other hooks must be barbless. A maximum of 2 trebles or 2 doubles is permitted on any one trace.**
8. Bait boats are allowed.
9. Braid not to be used as a main line.
10. Rods must not be left unattended. All anglers to remain with their rods. For any absence, lines must be withdrawn from the water and bait removed.
11. Any inappropriate behaviour ie loud music, use of floodlights, aggression towards other fisherman, unreasonable behaviour will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the site.
