MATCH RULES



These rules will be monitored and evolved to suit. We do of course welcome any constructive feedback

- You must have a valid rod licence to fish anywhere onsite
- Barbless Hooks Size 10 Maximum
- No Braided Mainline or Hook lengths
- No Artificial Baits (Wafers are allowed)
- All feeder and bomb rigs must free run back to the rod tip. No back stoppers, knots or otherwise between feeder and rod tip.
- All Method Feeders should be free running or of the X Safe elasticated variety. No back stops of any kind between feeder and rod tip.
- All Keepnets to be laid out on arrival at peg and put in water 15 minutes before match commences to assist in bio security of the complex.
- Keepnets are to be used as follows. Use 3 x Keepnets and split your fish evenly throughout the match.
- All fish are to be landed by use of landing net and should be unhooked and placed in Keepnets whilst remaining in the landing net head.
- Any large carp (Over 15lb) If possible advise bailiff so the fish can be moved to a specimen lake. Your pegs water is halfway to the next angler and halfway across the lake.
- Any Carp over 10lb should be weighed separately and not placed in keepnets.
- You have 15 minutes after the whistle to end the match, to land your fish, for it to count towards your weight.
- No swimming permitted.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead or tether at all times.
