

Pike Fishing Rules



Please be kind enough to observe the following rules: -

Please note Day Fishing Tickets are valid from 7am until 7pm.

- You must have a valid rod licence to fish anywhere onsite.
- Pike fishing is only allowed between October the 1st to March the 31st.
- Pike fishing on the River Wensum is only allowed between October the 1st to March the 14th
- All anglers must have a purpose-made weigh sling, unhooking mat, and a landing net suitable for specimen fish.
- Every angler must have the correct unhooking equipment with them. As a minimum you MUST have a pair of forceps and side cutters. Gags for unhooking of any pike are not allowed and are illegal in the UK. Both salt and fresh water baits are allowed
- Live baits are not to be used onsite.
- You must use a suitable wire trace system on all setups.
- Braid is allowed but must be a minimum of 20lbs breaking strain.
- No more than one bait is allowed on any set up, with a maximum of 2 hooks per bait.
- All pike anglers must be experienced at unhooking the fish, or accompanied by someone who is.
- All pike caught must be handled with care.
- No swimming permitted.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead or tether at all times.
- Lure Fishing is allowed
- Suitable traces should be used.
- A Landing Net must be carried at all times
- An Unhooking Mat must be carried at all times
- You must carry the necessary unhooking tools
- If pike fishing with lures you must be experienced at unhooking pike or be accompanied by someone who is
