

BASIL TODD, LAKE 6 MATCH RULES



Basil Todd Lake 6 (Match Rules)

- **Barbless Hooks Size 10 Maximum**
- **No Braided Mainline or Hook lengths**
- **You may use braid on a bait up rod only**
- **No Artificial Baits (Wafers are allowed)**
- **All feeder and bomb rigs must free run back to the rod tip. If using a backstop between feeder and rod tip, for example on a helicopter rig it must be able to move with minimal force.**
- **All Method Feeders must be free running or X Safe type feeders.**
- **All Keepnets and landing nets are supplied by the fishery. Anglers must not bring their own nets on site.**
- **Keepnets are to be used as follows.**
- **Silvers Matches – At discretion of the match organiser.**
- **Carp matches – 2 nets split fish equally. There may be times match organisers are advised to use 3 and then the rule will be 3 nets and again split fish evenly across the 3 nets.**
- **All fish which are over hand size are to be landed by use of landing net and should be unhooked and placed in Keepnets whilst remaining in the landing net head.**
- **Your pegs water is halfway to the next angler and halfway across the lake.**
- **Any Carp over 10lb should be weighed separately and not placed in keepnets.**
- **You have 15 minutes after the whistle to end the match, to land your fish, for it to count towards your weight.**

Any queries re Match Rules the organisers decision is final.
